The visiting expert will report to the Head of Operations.

### 2. Main Tasks and Responsibilities

- To review the current cybercrime and cyber intelligence capability in the areas of counter terrorism and organised crime within the Ministry of Interior (MoI);
- To support MoI in the establishment of new processes, organisational structure, strategies and/or legal framework relevant to the development of cybercrime and cyber intelligence capability;
- To take part in the daily advisory work embedded in MoI and develops a strong working partnership with key Iraqi interlocutors;
- To deliver workshops on relevant aspects of cybercrime and cyber intelligence to strengthen Iraqi ownership of future development work;
- To conduct administrative tasks and reporting in relation to his/her work, including a final report/action plan with recommendations on the way ahead;
