They will also address the international **legal framework** on PoC, the **evolution and history of PoC** mandates in the UN, the current **PoC mandate missions**, different **tiers and/or operational phases** of PoC, **vulnerable groups**, and special mechanisms for their protection.

Lectures will be delivered by **trainers with a wide range of experience in UN peacekeeping** and will help participants **develop skills with various learning methods** (practical examples, exercises, simulations, and group work).
